Was the vision immediately clear to Daniel?</p> <p>The Interpreter, V15-19 Do not forget that Daniel was led from one vision to another. Each vision would throw more light on the previous ones. Who was this interpreter? What was the vision about, V17-19?</p> <p>The interpretation, V20-25 Daniel knew from the dream image of Nebuchadnezzar that there were to be Four World Wide Empires, symbolized by gold, silver, brass and iron, Dan 2:36-40. He was not told their names, except the first Babylon. Neither in the vision of the four wild beasts, Dan. 7, given 62 years later, BC 541. He was only told that they were four kingdoms, V23. But in this vision of the Ram and the He-Goat, the names were given and Daniel knew then that the end of the Babylonian empire was at hand. This knowledge may have helped Daniel to interpret the writing on the wall, Dan. 5.</p> <p>Who do you think the large horn of the goat represents? And the four horns after?</p> <p>Without Hand, V23-25 Refer to Dan. 11:36-39. ³⁶ "Then the king shall do according to his own will: he shall exalt and magnify himself above every god, shall speak blasphemies against the God of gods, and shall prosper till the wrath has been accomplished; for what has been determined shall be done. ³⁷ He shall regard neither</p>

	<i>the ¹⁰God of his fathers nor the desire of women, nor regard any god; for he shall exalt himself above them all. ³⁸But in their place he shall honor a god of fortresses; and a god which his fathers did not know he shall honor with gold and silver, with precious stones and pleasant things. ³⁹Thus he shall act against the strongest fortresses with a foreign god, which he shall acknowledge, and advance its glory; and he shall cause them to rule over many, and divide the land for ¹⁰gain.</i>
