***Ecc. 1:9**, That which has been is what will be, That which is done is what will be done, And there is nothing new under the sun.*

Ecclesiastes 1:9, ⁹ *That **which has been is what will be**, That **which is done is what will be done**,
And there is nothing new under the sun.*

Isaiah 41:22-23, ²² *“Let them bring forth and show us what will happen; Let them show the former things,
what they were, That we may [a]consider them, And know the latter end of them; Or declare to us things to
come. ²³ Show the things that are to come hereafter, That we may know that you are gods; Yes, do good or do
evil, That we may be dismayed and see it together.*

Ecclesiastes 3:15, ¹⁵ *That which is has already been, And what is to be has already been;
And God [a]requires an account of [b]what is past.*

Isaiah 46:9-10, ⁹ *Remember the former things of old, For I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there
is none like Me, ¹⁰ Declaring the end from the beginning, And from ancient times things that are not yet done,
Saying, ‘My counsel shall stand, And I will do all My pleasure,*

Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever, **Heb. 13:8**.
